

Eunice Shang-Simpson is a member of the Ghana Bar, a solicitor-advocate qualified to practice in England and Wales, and an international arbitrator. She is presently a Lecturer Practitioner in Law at Canterbury Christ Church University, Kent, UK.

She is an Accredited Civil & Commercial Mediator, having trained with the ADR Group in 2020.

Eunice is a former Specialist Crown Prosecutor with extensive experience in complex cross-border criminal prosecutions and mutual legal assistance. She was a seconded national expert (SNE) to the UK Desk at Eurojust in the Hague and dealt with several successful cross-border prosecutions. As an SNE, her role was to represent the interests of the UK in negotiations with EU countries in respect of matters pertaining to Justice and Home Affairs.
