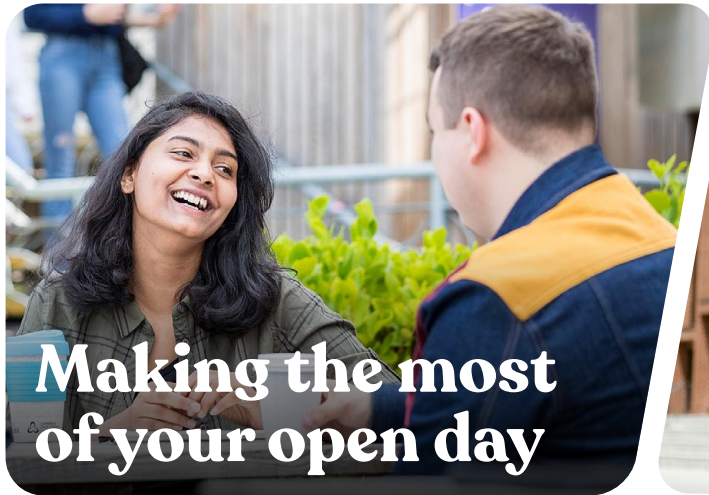

Accessible accommodation

Our accommodation team work to ensure that there is at least one accessible room open during the event. Please ask a member of staff in the tour hub for details.

Accessible routes around campus

The accessible entrances to our buildings are marked by orange triangles on the campus map, see page 32. We have step free routes around campus. If you'd like to be shown one of these routes, just ask one of our friendly student helpers or speak to a member of staff in the tour hub and they will arrange a bespoke tour for you.

Assistance dogs

Assistance dogs are welcome on campus. We have a spending pen where they can go to the loo – see the campus map on page 32 for location.

Baby changing and breastfeeding facilities

These can be found in our Laud and Verena Holmes buildings.

Chapel and multifaith rooms

We welcome students from all backgrounds, all ages, all faiths or no faith at all. We have a Canterbury-based Chapel, a Muslim Prayer Room, a Buddhist Meditation Room and quiet rooms on all campuses, supported and supervised by the Chaplaincy Team. Campus tours

Options for going on a tour:

Student-led

Viewing our accommodation

Our accommodation is all self-catering and in walking distance of campus. During the event, we'll have flats open between 10:00-15:00 in Lanfranc, St George's, Petros Court and Pin Hill. To help you decide which site(s) to view, see the site descriptors below:

Lanfranc – is one of the closest sites to campus and has a community feel based around a central grassy quad. It's handy for popping into town, the supermarket or the new Riverside entertainment centre which is only minutes away. Lanfranc is mid-priced and rooms are ensuite.

St George's – is located at the top of the high street and shares a site with the Lounge, which is the student bar. It's ideally situated between campus and Augustine House, our library and student services building, so you're only a few minutes walk away from both. St George's is towards the higher end of the scale in terms of price, and rooms are ensuite.

Petros Court – is located behind Augustine House, our library and student services building – you'll be close to the city centre and transport links. Petros Court is one of our more expensive accommodation sites – all rooms are ensuite.

Pin Hill – is located near the city centre and is just a 2-minute walk to Augustine House, our Library and student services building. It's also very close to transport links into London. Pin Hill has a mixture of ensuite and non-ensuite rooms and offers some of our lower priced accommodation.

To view flats at these sites, you'll need to join a **walking bus** leaving every 20 minutes from Powell Lecture Theatre, Pg09 between 10am-3pm.
