We're here to help with your questions. You'll find students and staff across campus who are looking forward to meeting you and to help you make the most of your visit.


Help in an emergency

Accessible accommodation

Campus tours

Options for going on a tour:

Student-led

Our students will be giving guided campus tours of the Medway Campus throughout the event. Tours leave every 10 minutes from Rowan Williams Court, RWg19 and take approximately 25 minutes.

These tours are a great way to get a student's view of campus as well as getting your bearings and a feel for the wider campus beyond your course. Our tour guides are happy to answer questions about student life and Medway in general.

Self guided

We've produced a self-guided tour booklet, so if you'd prefer, you can show yourself around campus. The booklet is packed with info as well as suggesting a route that takes in the must-see parts of campus. If you get stuck while using the booklet, just ask any member of staff or student helper for advice.

Booklets can be found at the check-in desk as well as in your welcome bag (you can collect yours when you check-in).

Other places to visit:

Drill Hall Library

Don't forget to visit the Drill Hall Library. At 184 metres long, it's thought to be the longest library in Europe and contains 2.7 miles of shelving, an extensive collection of around 130,000 books and journals, 400 computers and 100 netbooks/ laptops, training rooms, and discussion spaces.

It's situated in a grade 2 listed building that was part of the historic Chatham dockyards.

The Hub

Next to the Drill Hall Library, the Hub is home to the Students' Union including the Deep End, bar and coffee shop. Once the site of a swimming pool and skittles alley, this listed building provides a vibrant entertainment and social space, including a modern bar, live music stages, huge screen for cinema and sports and offers a great range of food.


Accommodation



Accommodation is all self-catering and based off campus. During the event, we'll have flats open between 10:00-14:00 in Pier Quays for you to view. There will be a shuttle bus taking visitors to Pier Quays throughout the day or you can join a student led walking bus leaving approximately every 20 minutes from RWg19 in Rowan Williams Court between 10:00-14:00.

Driving to Pier Quays


Head west on North Road, continuing onto Pembroke and at the roundabout, take the third exit onto Maritime Way. At the next roundabout, take the third exit onto the Pier Road / A289 ramp to M2 / A2 / Sittingbourne / Rainham / Chatham Docks. Merge onto Pier Road / A289, and then turn left onto Pegasus Way. Turn right onto Blake Avenue.

Walking to Pier Quays

From Rowan Williams Court turn left, continue past the Sports Hall on the right, to the ramp at the end of Campus. Walk straight along the road, past the police station on the right, then cross at the traffic lights. Continue along the road and Pier Quays is on the left hand side. It takes approximately 20 minutes to walk.
