The uniform allocation listed above is issued free of charge for all students when they join their course. The uniform students are provided with in their first year is expected to last for the duration of their degree. If students join CCCU as a new student in their second or third year, they will be issued some uniform free of charge, however the quantity is decided on a case-by-case basis.

Diagnostic Radiography students / students using ionising radiation – please note students will also be issued with a Thermoluminescent dosimeter. They will receive a separate communication from <u>health.business-operations@canterbury.ac.uk</u> with further information.



Paramedic Science students – please note SECAmb will also supply students with a safety helmet, Hi-Vis jacket, Hi-Vis trousers, and safety boots. 2. Uniform

- **2.1. Delivery Time** If ordering uniform, students should allow up to 6 weeks for delivery time. If a subsequent exchange of uniform is required, students will need to allow a potential further 6 weeks for delivery.
- **2.2. Uniform not collected** If the Uniform Team order uniform/a placement badge on a student's behalf and it is not collected from campus within 14 days (from when they are notified of its arrival), it will be returned to our supplier.
- **2.3. Returns** If students need to return their uniform because of incorrect sizing, they should contact <u>health.uniform@canterbury.ac.uk</u>.
- **2.4.** Faulty Items If students have any problems with their uniform, they should report these items to <u>health.uniform@canterbury.ac.uk</u> within 14 days of receiving them. Please note that delays in reporting issues may result in students having to replace the uniform at their own expense.
- **2.5.** Additional Items If students wish to order uniform at any point in addition to their course allocated uniform, they will be required to purchase this at their own expense directly with the supplier. They should contact <u>health.uniform@canterbury.ac.uk</u> for guidance.
- **2.6.** Uniform Care Students should always read the care label and washing instructions on the inside of their garments before washing.

3. Alternative Uniform

3.1. Please note that our uniform supplier refers to some styles of garments as male or female. It is important that student uniform is practical, and students are comfortable in what they are wearing on placement. Therefore, when students are fitted with their uniform, they will be able to choose the style/fit they most prefer. Individual Circumstances

- **3.2. Maternity** Two sets of maternity uniform are available at any point during a student's studies. The Uniform Team will supply these free of charge. Please allow up to 6 weeks for items to arrive from date of order. Please contact <u>health.uniform@canterbury.ac.uk</u>.
- **3.3. Medical** Placement uniform is already agreed and allocated; if a student has a medical requirement for alternative uniform, they should speak to their Personal Academic Tutor, who will liaise with the Uniform Team accordingly.
- **3.4. Religious** Placement uniform is already agreed and allocated; if a student has a religious requirement for alternative uniform, they should speak to their Personal Academic Tutor, who will liaise with the Uniform Team accordingly.

3.5. Placement Name Badges

- **3.6. Preferred Name** On placement, students will be required to wear a name badge,ⁱ which is an additional item of uniform. Before starting their studies, they will be asked to provide their preferred first name, which will be printed on their placement badge.
- **3.7. Replacement Badge** If students lose or break their placement badge, they will be required to purchase a new one at their own expense by contacting <u>health.uniform@canterbury.ac.uk</u>. Students should allow up to 6 weeks for delivery.
