ASSESSMENT

- 1 All modules contain a 'Portfolio' component of assessment, with the exception of the Dissertation/Individual Study and Level 7 modules.
- 2 The 'Portfolio' is not weighted and must be passed.
- 3 Assessment of the 'Portfolio' component of assessment is pass/fail only.
- 4 A pass constitutes 50% or more skills passed and must include any listed as "required".

- 5 All other components of assessment in a module containing a 'Portfolio' will have indicative word count/equivalence reduced by 10% across the module. This will not affect the component weightings.
- 6 It is not possible to pass a module at any level without passing the 'Portfolio' component of assessment.
- 7 At Level 0 and Level 4, the 60-credit threshold for reassessment with attendance does not apply in the specific instances where the student has passed academic components of the module but not passed the Portfolio (and therefore the module overall). In this instance, reassessment for the 'Portfolio' shall be offered as follows:
 - a) A student's first reassessment attempt must be taken in the next available timetabled assessment period in the same academic year;
 - b) a student's second reassessment attempt must be taken in the next academic year as reassessment with attendance.
- 8 Trail and progress is not permitted on this course.

COMPENSATION

- 9 A module containing a 'Portfolio' may only be compensated, in line with the University regulations for compensation, if the 'Portfolio' has been passed.
- 10 All Dissertation/Individual Study modules are excluded from the University regulations for compensation:
 - i. Honours Project in Animal Science;
 - ii. Honours Project in Biochemistry & Genetics;
 - iii. Honours Project in Biomedical Science;
 - iv. Honours Project in Bioscience;
 - v. Honours Project in Food Science & Nutrition;
 - vi. Honours Project in Geography;
 - vii. Honours Project in Human Biology;
 - viii. Honours Project in Plant Science;
 - ix. Honours Project in Wildlife Ecology & Conservation Science.
- 11 The Level 7 Research Project module is excluded from the University regulations for compensation:
 - i. Research Project in Biomedical Science.

REASSESSMENT AND PROGRESSION

- 12 The Portfolio component of assessment in each module is subject to two reassessment attempts.
