INTRODUCTION

AWARD

- 1. Only a student who successfully meets the requirements for the BSc (Hons) Sports Therapy & Rehabilitation and passes the Professional Practice modules at each level will be eligible as a Graduate Sports Rehabilitator (GSR) and registration with the British Association of Sport Rehabilitators and Trainers (BASRaT).
- 2. Aegrotat awards do not provide eligibility to apply for registration with the British Association of Sport Rehabilitators and Trainers (BASRaT).

ASSESSMENT

- 3. At Levels 4-6, all components of assessment must be passed.
- 4. A student will be deemed to have failed the Experiential Learning (Supervised Practice) components if they have not completed the minimum supervised practice hours by the end of the exceptional reassessment period for the Level.

COMPENSATION

- 5. Compensation is not permitted on the BSc (Hons) Sports Therapy & Rehabilitation at any Level from 4-6.
- 6. Compensation at Levels 4-6 shall only be offered after all reassessment attempts have been offered.

ALTERNATIVE EXIT AWARDS

- 7. At Level 4, a student who has not passed Professional Practice 1 (after reassessment) or has had compensation applied, will be required to exit with a CertHE Sports Injury Management or transfer to the BSc (Hons) Sport & Exercise Science to continue their studies.
- 8. At Level 5, a student who has not passed Professional Practice 2 (after reassessment) or has had compensation applied, will be required to exit with a CertHE / DipHE Sports Injury Management or transfer to the BSc (Hons) Sport & Exercise Science to continue their studies.
- 9. At Level 6, a student who has had compensation applied will be awarded the appropriate BSc (Hons) Sports Injury Management exit award.
- 10. At Level 6, a student who has not passed Professional Practice 3 (after reassessment), will be eligible to exit with a BSc (Hons) Sports Therapy & Rehabilitation but will not be reported as eligible as a Graduate Sports Rehabilitator (GSR) to BASRaT.

REASSESSMENT

11. Non completion of the Experiential Learning (Supervised Practice) [EL SP] is treated as a fail. Where students are eligible for reassessment at the end of the year they have until the end of the exceptional reassessment period to complete the EL SP.

PROGRESSION BETWEEN LEVELS

12. Trail and progress is not permitted on this course.

CREDIT EXEMPTION ON ENTRY

13. Recognition of Prior Learning is not permitted unless transferring from a BASRaT Accredited Programme.
